FIRST CATEGORY OF MITZVAHS

פרושים מקובלים מפי משה

Logical mitzvahs received from Moshe

- Derived from the text
- Hidden within wording of the text
- Indisputable mitzvahs

Example of this type of mitzvah



Esrog is found in the Torah called פרי עץ הדור. Using logic we confirm what torah is referring to.

הלכה למשה מסיני - Second category

Meaning Halachot given to
Moshe at har Sinai

- not proved in the text
- Indisputable

Example: Indisputable that תפילין must be black



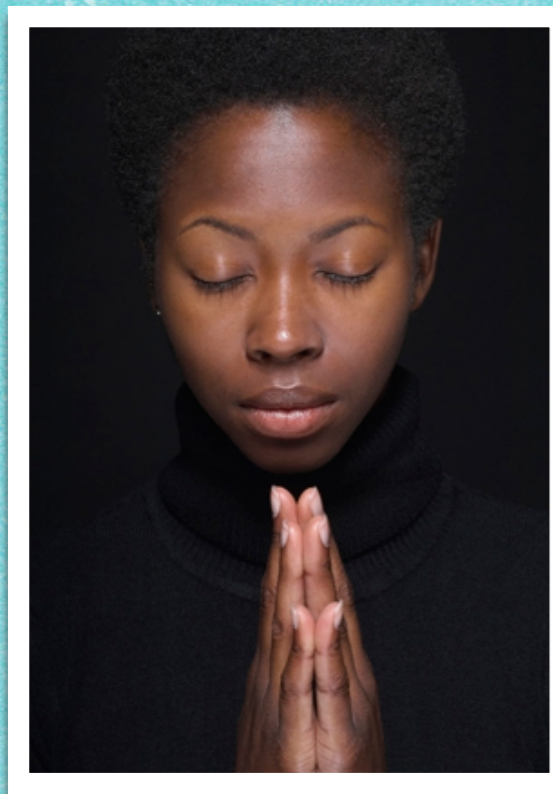
3rd category of mitzvah -Talmudic laws

Talmudic laws are debated in Gemarah

- laws decided through logic
- laws are debated between rabbis
- whichever rabbi has the majority (amount of rabbis that agree), wins.
- by debating, they verify that logic of laws are correct



Example: whether or not women are allowed to join a zimun.

4th category- גזרות

Laws that prophets and rabbis imposed to protect torah laws



- depending on how well known the gizarah (fence) is- its either disputable or indisputable
- Rabbis prohibit an action in order to protect Yiddin from violating torah

מוקצה & מלאכה

- mooksah is a law the rabbis created to protect a yiddin from violating a milacha



5th category - תקנות ומנהגים - regulations and customs

They are not actual mitzvahs, however they are strictly customs and regulations that can't be violated



Real, but not!!



Examples:

Lighting a Chanukiah helps an individual do the mitzvah of publicizing the miracle



Sorry your birthday cake requires so many more candles than a menorah.
